MIDDLE SCHOOL (GRADES 7-9)

Our bilingual programme in Grades 7 to 9 is tailored specifically to cover content knowledge and skills in English and German.

There is a learning sequence: students cover the subjects in English, while reinforcing concepts related to the content in German and vice versa. Hence students simultaneously acquire substantial knowledge of various topics and feel confident talking about the subject matter in either language.

PRE-DIPLOMA PROGRAMME (GRADE 10)

This grade is a preparatory phase before students enroll in a Diploma programme next year. The learning process is organized in a way that allows Grade 10 students to improve their language skills, accustom to the new studying environment, try and evaluate different subjects, and gain a final understanding of what they are going to take for the Diploma programme in Grades 11-12.

SKIS Career Counselling Team helps students explore the potential college venues to facilitate their choice of the Diploma subjects.

HIGH SCHOOL (GRADES 11-12)

Students in Grades 11-12 start their Diploma programme. Our school is currently offering two options - IB DP and Alevels. Both programmes provide high-quality international education in English language and are recognised by the universities worldwide.

BACCALAUREATE DIPLOMA PROGRAMME (IB DP)



The IB DP is an international standard of secondary school education with a balanced academic programme and robust final examinations, recognised by the world's leading universities in 140+ countries.

The curriculum is made up of the DP core and six subject groups.

Group 1- Studies in language and literature

Group 2 - Language acquisition

Group 3 - Individuals and societies

Group 4 - Sciences

Group 5 - Mathematics

Group 6 - The arts

Each student takes at least three (but not more than four) subjects at higher level (HL), and the remaining at standard level (SL). Standard level subjects take up 150 teaching hours. Higher level comprises 240 teaching hours.

All the classes (apart from a non-English Language A) and examinations are held in English language.

In addition to the subjects studied, the DP also includes three key elements which enhance the educational experience of the students and encourage them to put their knowledge, skills and abilities to practical work:

- an extended essay
- theory of knowledge (TOK)
- creativity, activity, service (CAS)

GCE ADVANCED LEVEL (A-LEVELS)



The A-Level is an internationally renowned academic programme recognised in the UK, US, Austria, Germany and other popular college destinations.

Upon the completion of the A-Levels, students receive the British General Certificate of Secondary Education (GCSE) Advanced Level.

Each student selects 3 to 6 subjects to study and have a final examination on. Students have classes for 20 to 25 academic hours a week: 16 hours are devoted to thesubjects of their choice, and 5 to 8 hours - to English. Creative classes and sports are optional.

The programme is divided into two one-year parts: AS (Advanced Subsidiary) and A2 (AL). Students receive an AS-Level certificate at the end of the first year in Grade 11, and an A2-Level certificate following the completion of the Grade 12. Then they take A-Level exams to receive a diploma.






International School fall into 4 categories:


STUDENT LEADERSHIP SYSTEM

Schloss Krumbach International School is Austria's first and only school-castle.

Located in the Bucklige Welt, we are exposed to one the most beautiful parts of the country, on the easter edge of the Alps. The surrounding area is also known as the Land of the Thousand Hills, a poetic reference to a large number of hills enclosing the castle in a green forestry hug.

Krumbach Fortress was first built in the 11th century, but the current building dates to the 13th Century. The estate passed into the possession of noble Pálffy von Erdöd family in 1629 and served as a hotel for the last 30 years.

Prior to becoming a school in 2020, the castle underwent a significant renovation in accordance with the international standards on boarding schools. We currently have the most advanced learning equipment and the newest student facilities and accommodation.

TRIPS

We are a boarding school but we believe in traveling and seeing the world. Located at the crossroads of Europe, our school is extremely well-positioned: we can reach places without spending too much time on the road.

Seeing in real life the historical and cultural sites, museums, and galleries one has just studied in class is a truly gratifying experience. Some of thetrips are mandatory for all the students and are integrated into the school schedule for each of the Grades.

There are also additional reward trips for students who excel academically or demonstrate an eager involvement in the school life. These trips are designed as an incentive for students to study better and become pro-active members of the SKIS community.


The 12-acre Schloss Krumbach estate is surrounded by majestic forests and alpine meadows.



ACCOMMODATION

Girls and boys occupy separate residential blocks







Each room is designed to accommodate two/three students and has all the necessary equipment:

- comfortable beds with orthopedic mattresses and snow white linens
- a range of zones to keep and store personal items: wardrobes, chests of drawers, sideboards
- a shared table with adjustable lighting
- every room comes en-site and has its own bathroom

Schloss Krumbach International School is located a 50-minute drive from Vienna. The school's perfect location allows our students to actively participate in all of the Austrian capital's major cultural even ts, regularly visit art and natural history museums, the Vienna State Opera and Philharmonic, as well as modern theatres and galleries.



SCHLOSS KRUMBACH INTERNATIONAL SCHOOL FEES

Schloss Krumbach International School believes in a multi-format boarding education.

Half-Board Programme [Monday-Friday] teaches students to excel in time management. With support of teachers and supervisors, they are able to complete all the assignments in advance, before the weekend starts. SKIS brings up high achievers, capable of combining intense studying with quality family time on Saturdays and Sundays. Although they spend weekends outside of school, half-board students still experience all the events, everyday sports and trips offered at SKIS.

Full Boarding Programme is an option for students who live and study at SKIS full-time [August 25th - June 20th minus school breaks as indicated in the schedule]. This is the most popular and effective way of learning because it grants a deeper immersion in studying and school life. Students have access to the whole spectrum of extracurricular activities, learning support, socialisation and culture trips organized by the school. Surrounded by their peers and supervisors rather than smart phones, full boarding students tend to perform better academically and in terms of soft skills.

Fees:

Application fee - 300 euro, paid following the application consultation and prior to school's visit/ test day/ entrance exams. This fee is non-refundable, but included in the academic fees in case of the student contract with the school.

Enrollment fee - amounts to 10% of both contracts. This fee is included in the academic fees, as indicated in the student contract, and is non-refundable in case of the student contract termination.

Refundable deposit - 3000 euro, paid extra to the academic fees, as indicated in the student contract. This fee is refundable and is paid prior to the beginning of classes.

TO SUCCESFULLY ENROLL IN OUR SCHOOL

Step 1. Get in touch with the Admissions Team for a free consultation on the application procedure.

Step 2. Send us the following documents per email:

- scanned copies of the certificate from the school with the final grades of the previous year and intermediate grades of the curren school year.
- a motivation letter in English: Why do I want to study at SKIS? (free form, 300 words).

Step 3. Pay an Application Fee of 300 euro. The Application Fee is a necessary requirement to proceed to the interview.

Step 4. Once all the required documents are received, our Admissions Officer will send you an email outlining all the available interview slots, and you will indicate which time works for you.


Step 5. Student Interview. One of our linguistic experts will interview an applicant in English to test the level of language and overall erudition.

Step 6. Wait for the interview results. In case of acceptance, we will send you a student contract for review.

Step 7. Sign a contract and pay the annual fees to book your spot at Schloss Krumbach International School for the next academic year.

Step 8. Move to our beautiful castle to hop on an exciting academic, linguistic, social and cultural journey. Welcome to SKIS!
